








LETTER FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Wishing you all a safe and enjoyable mid-term.



HOPE FUNDRAISING
















During the WEEK OF HOPE, Leaving Cert LCVP students raised a total of €3,896 by selling Butler's Chocolate to the people of Galway so far.




